## WineBiz desk launched

### - Boosting government collaboration



In a step towards enhancing collaboration with government, the South African wine and brandy industry will launch the WineBiz desk, with a dedicated stakeholder manager, in November 2015.

The new strategic service will operate under the auspices of the industry organisations VinPro and Salba (SA Liquor Brandowners' Association), from the offices of Agbiz (Agricultural Business Chamber) in Pretoria. Its main focus will be strengthening relationships with various national government departments and related stakeholders on key issues such as water and land reform, transformation, trade facilitation and market access, while promoting the image of the South African wine and brandy industry. 


## Agbiz meets with French Embassy on Climate Change initiative

## International Trade Intelligence

### Southern African Development Community (SADC) Grain Trade

#### - What does the data say?



In 2014, the Southern African Development Community (SADC) region's total commercial consumption of maize, wheat, and sorghum was 39 million tons (USDA, 2014) against regional production of 34 million tons. Overall, the SADC region is a net importer of the above-mentioned grains, and the region imports US\$868 million more than it exports to the world (ITC, 2015). Wheat and sorghum imports constituted a US\$1.2 billion and US\$4.6 million deficit, respectively, which is

nonetheless, offset by a positive trade balance in maize which accounted for US\$376 million. In the [linked article](#), Tinashe Kapuya and Wandile Sihlobo explore the regional trade structure for these commodities.
