AAN ALLE LEDE BETROKKE BY SERTIFISERING VAN SAAD

OMSENDSKRYWE: SERTIFISERINGSVORMS

Na aanleiding van 'n besluit geneem deur die SANSOR Bestuurskomitee en waarna daar opdrag gegee is dat daar verhoogde tariewe gehief moet word vir sertifisering van saad wat geproduseer word ingevolge die bepalings van Internasionale Saadskemas, naamlik OECD, AOSCA en SADC wanneer dit geïmplementeer word, asook bevinding tydens 'n onlangse Sertifiseringstelsel Oudit uitgevoer deur die Departement van Landbou, Bosbou en Vissery (DAFF), was ons genoodsaak om die "AANSOEK OM REGISTRASIE VAN 'N STUK GROND AS 'N EENHEID", sowel as die "VOORLOPIGE SERTIFIKAAT" vorms aan te pas. Dit is gedoen om voorsiening te maak vir die aanduiding deur die aansoeker vir watter Sertifiseringskemas die betrokke eenheid geregistreer word en watter sertifikate uitgereik moet word..

Sommige maatskappye wat self die vorm elektronies gedupliseer het, gebruik nog die ou Suid-Afrikaanse Wapen – dit moet vervang word met die nuwe Wapen, wat op aanvraag by SANSOR beskikbaar is. Alle self-ontwerpte vorms wat gebruik word vir Sertifiseringsdoeleindes moet aan die SANSOR Tegnieese Bestuurder voorgelê word vir goedkeuring voor 11 Julie 2014, waarna alle aansoeke om registrasies vir sertifisering wat nie op goedgekeurde vorms gedoen word, nie meer aanvaar sal word nie. Maatskappye wat na 1 Julie 2014 nalaat om tydens registrasie aan te dui vir watter Skemas registrasie aangevra word of 'n eenheid slegs vir Nasionale Sertifisering registreer en dan daarna aansoek doen vir die uitreiking van OECD, AOSCA of SADC Sertifikate, sal dan vir R200.00 per Sertifikaat aangeslaan word om die addisionele adminstrasie te dek – dit sal betaalbaar moet word voordat die betrokke Sertifikaat uitgereik word.

Aangeheg vind die betrokke vorms wat in die toekoms gebruik moet word – dit is ook in boekvorm (met deurslag kopieë) by SANSOR beskikbaar en kan by Tessa Kleyn by techman@sansor.co.za bestel word. Die vorms sal ook binnekort beskikbaar wees op die SANSOR Webblad by <http://sansor.org/circulars/>. Maatskappye wat nog ou boeke wat deur SANSOR verskaf is in voorraad het, kan voortgaan om dit te gebruik, met die voorwaarde dat daar addisioneel op die vorm aangedui word vir watter Skemas aansoek gedoen word, en in die geval van aansoek om registrasies, asook wie die inspeksies gaan uitvoer.

TO ALL MEMBERS INVOLVED WITH CERTIFICATION

CIRCULAR: CERTIFICATION FORMS

Following a decision made by the SANSOR Management Committee and the subsequent instruction that separated fees must be charged for the certification of seed produced according to International Seed Schemes, namely OECD, AOSCA and SADC (when the last-mentioned is implemented), as well as findings during a recent Certification System Audit conducted by the Department of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries (DAFF), we were obliged to amend the "APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION OF A PIECE OF LAND AS A UNIT", as well as the "Preliminary Certificate" forms. That was done to provide for the indication from the applicant for which Certification Scheme the unit concerned is being registered and which Certificate should be issued.

Some of the companies that have duplicated electronic versions of the certification forms themselves, still uses the old South-African Coat-of-Arms – this should be replaced with the new version which is available from SANSOR on request. All self-designed forms that are used for certification purposes must be submitted to the SANSOR Technical Manager for approval before 11 July 2014, after which all applications for registration which are not done on approved forms will not be accepted. Companies that do not indicate after 1 July 2014 on application for registration form for which certification Schemes registration are required, or only register a unit for National Certification but eventually requests that OECD, AOSCA or SADC Certificates be issued, will then be charged R200.00 per Certificate to cover the additional administration – proof of payment will be required before the Certificates will be issued.

Attached please find the approved forms that must be used in future – it is also available from SANSOR as a book (with carbonised copies) and can be ordered from Tessa Kleyn at techman@sansor.co.za. The forms will also be available soon on the SANSOR Website at <http://sansor.org/circulars/>.

Companies that still have old books that have been supplied by SANSOR in stock, may continue using it with the provision that the information regarding the Schemes for which application is made, is indicated additionally on the form. In the case of application for registration, the authorised inspector who is going to conduct the inspections must be indicated as well.
